Milan Hlaveš, M.A., Ph.D., curator of the collection of glass in Museum of Decorative Arts and Rony Plesl, M.F.A, head of the glass atelier at the Academy of Arts, Architecture and Design in Prague participate in the creation of the **Glass.Classic** exhibition.

Multidimensional and unconventionally conceived project has much to offer both the theoreticians of fine arts and glass-making artists and amateurs, lovers of glass as well as random passer-by tourists. With reference to the most famous Czech glass artist and knowing of a great history of Czech glass-making, „**the Stanislav Libenský Award and Glass.Classic**“ contribute to the future of the field that may be experiencing tough times now, but still represents a significant potential.
